


## Special Needs Registry

The Brown County Board of DD and the 911 Communications Center have teamed up to develop a system to gather and store information given on a form that an individual, family member or friend fill out with important information about individuals who may not be able to tell an operator about themselves in a time of emergency. A "Special Needs" picture identification card will be made by The Brown County Board of Developmental Disabilities with important information on the back of the card that would help someone who may need emergency treatment should the individual be unresponsive. The 911 Communication Center will also have this information close at hand and to be able to give information to first responders in route if an emergency situation should arise.
