At this time, we are carefully evaluating the impact of the levy results on our operations. This includes a comprehensive review of our budget and available resources. Our goal is to identify a responsible path forward that prioritizes compliance with state and federal requirements while maintaining the highest level of service possible within the restraints of our available funds.

We recognize that these discussions may bring uncertainty, and we are committed to maintaining transparency as decisions are made. We will keep families, staff, and community members informed throughout the process.

Our mission remains unchanged. We are dedicated to supporting the individuals and families we serve, and we are working diligently to ensure continuity of care during this period of evaluation.
